Dear Mr. Knight:

The Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) has received your Registration for a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Event in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 362-4 dated April 12, 2019.

Your registration is validated for the collection day events at Lansing Park, James Street, Cohoes, NY on June 8, 2019.

Please note as the program sponsor, your agency is responsible for enforcement of these conditions during the course of the collection event.

1. Only the waste outlined in the HHW Collection Plan may be accepted. Waste may be accepted from individual households and Conditionally Exempt Small Quality Generators (CESQGs) only, as described in the plan.
2. No wastes may be accepted from regulated hazardous waste generators.
3. Any changes in the Collection Plan must be submitted to this office, in writing, and DEC approval must be received prior to implementation of the requested change.
4. Compliance with all applicable requirements of 6 NYCRR Subpart 362-4, including but not limited to:
 - a. All HHW must be transported by a hauler permitted to transport hazardous waste under 6 NYCRR Part 364 and ONLY in vehicles properly listed on the hauler's valid Part 364 waste transporter permit at the time of transport.

- b. All HHW must be transported to a facility which is permitted, licensed, or authorized to accept hazardous waste; and all HHW must be treated or disposed in the same manner as regulated hazardous waste.
 - c. All HHW must be properly packaged to prevent reactions, spills, or leaks, and containers must be labeled with the words "Household Hazardous Waste" or "Hazardous Waste" as appropriate.
 - d. The identity of the program sponsor, the date of collection, the intended receiving facility, the volume, the waste type, and the hazard class of the waste must be listed on the shipping document.
 - e. All shipping papers or manifests must be clearly marked "Household Hazardous Waste."
 - f. All waste must be removed from the collection site within three (3) days of collection, and the site must be returned to its original condition.
5. The collection event plan must be available at the collection site during collection hours.
 6. The program sponsor or the vendor or any of their agents who have knowledge of a spill, contamination or release of any waste into the environment must report the discovery of such spill, contamination or release to the NYS Spill Hotline (1-800-457-7362) immediately.
 7. As the program sponsor it is your responsibility to ensure that all permits and certifications necessary to manage, transport and dispose of collected materials are in full effect for the duration of this authorization.
 8. The program sponsor is required to report annually the amounts of household hazardous waste and CESQGs waste collected; therefore, tracking of the waste at each collection event is crucial. The annual report form is due by March 1 for the previous calendar year. The annual report form is available at:

 9. Collected electronics must be protected from the weather, and securely kept in containers, on vehicles, or indoors.
 10. No disassembly of electronic components is allowed at the collection site.

Please be advised that any incident of non-compliance with any of the conditions in this letter, or of any applicable provision of 6 NYCRR Subpart 362-4 will be considered an immediate and complete termination of this registration and may result in additional enforcements actions by the Department.


